

Notice of Race PCCSC Men's and Women's Single-handed Conference Championships October 24-26, 2014

Host: Stanford University, Arrillaga Boathouse Redwood City, CA

Waters: South San Francisco Bay off of Redwood Creek

Boats: The regatta will be sailed in Lasers (Men) and Radials (Women). Each competitor must provide one complete Class Legal Laser (Men) or Radial (Women). All boats and trailers will be brought to the Public Launch ramp in the port of Redwood City.

Eligibility: All PCCSC Regular or Provisional Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail. A maximum of 4 sailors per school will be allowed in each championship. As per the PCCSC Standing Rules, all competitors are required to wear their school pinnies.

Entries: A email must be sent to John Vandemoer with your intent to sail either by a Coach, Team representative or sailor by October 20 2014 in order to compete. Pleas put in the email the Sail # you will be using this must be a variation of your PCCSC sail #.

Entry Fee: Entry Fee is a fee to PCCSC. Danielle Richards, PCCSC Commissioner will be dealing with payment.

Format: The women's championship will be sailed on Friday. A minimum of five races must be completed and a maximum of 18 will be attempted. If five races are not completed Friday, they will be sailed Saturday morning.

The men's championship will be sailed on Saturday (following any women's races still to be sailed) and Sunday. A minimum of five races must be completed and a maximum of 18 will be attempted. The regatta will be a single division, non-rotational event. You will sail the boat that you bring. Top two finishers in each the men's and women's divisions will qualify for the 2014 ICSA Singlehanded National Championship.

Safety: U.S. Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type III, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.
