

2017 MCSA SINGLE-HANDED CHAMPIONSHIP HOSTED BY THE HOPE COLLEGE AND GVSU OCTOBER 14-15, 2017



NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority for the 2017 MCSA Single-Handed Championship will be: The Midwest Collegiate Sailing Association (MCSA) & the Inter Collegiate Sailing Association (ICSA).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, and by the ICSA Procedural Rules, the MCSA Standing Rules, MCSA Championship Conditions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.2 All MCSA Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail.
- 2.3 Sailors must meet all ICSA eligibility requirements and may be required to verify enrollment at the school they are representing.

3. ENTRY

Cancellation Deadline: September 29, 2017

24 Hour Deadline: October 13, 2017

Teams wishing to withdraw from this event must notify the MCSA Race Chairman by the date specified above to avoid any fines or penalties.

4. FEES

4.1 There will be an entry fee of \$10 payable to GVSU Club Sailing. Entry fees are due by the close of registration on Saturday morning.

6. BOATS/SAILS

- 6.1 Each competitor entered is responsible for providing one complete class legal Laser/Radial.
- 6.2 Hope/GVSU does not have charter boats available

7. FORMAT/ROTATIONS

7.1 Competitors will sail the boats/sails they brought for the duration of the event.

8. QUALIFICATION

8.1 This event shall serve as the MCSA Qualifier for the ICSA Men's & Women's Single-Handed National Championship. The number of advancing teams is determined by the ICSA Championship Berth Allocations (http://collegesailing.org/resources/championship-allocations).

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 Sailing Instructions will be available online at scores.collegsailing.org

10. VENUE

10.1 The sailing area will inside on Lake Macatawa in front of MBYC, or on Lake Michigan within 1nm of the Holland Channel entrance.

11. THE COURSES

11.1 A Course Chart will be provided with the Sailing Instructions and will describe the marks and courses, including the approximate angle between the legs, the order in which marks are to be rounded or passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. Courses will be a windward-leeward configuration.

12. SCORING

12.1 The scoring system shall be as described in the ICSA procedural Rules.

13. COACHING

13.1 Coaching will be done from host provided support boats.

14. PROTESTS & APPEALS

14.1 In accordance with the ICSA Procedural Rules, the right of appeal is denied at all Conference Championships. Decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.
