



PCCSC Singlehanded Championships NOR September 22-23, 2018

RULES

The regatta will be governed by: the Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020), the ICSA Procedural Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, the International Laser Class Association Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions.

FORMAT

We will be racing in Emeryville Flats, outside Clipper Cove. There will be two different starts, one for men and one for women. Competitors will sail the boats/sails they brought for the duration of the event.

ELIGIBILITY

All PCCSC Regular or Provisional Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail. Sailors must meet all ICSA eligibility requirements and may be required to verify enrollment at the school they are representing.

ENTRY

Each school may enter up to 4 men and 4 women. There is a \$35 entry fee per boat to cover TISC launching fees. Checks can be made payable to "UC Regents - Sailing". This will be a non-rotational event.

Schools must confirm their attendance and the number of boats by 1700 hrs Wednesday, September 19th to the PCCSC Regatta Sign-Up Google Doc:

QUALIFICATION

This event shall serve as the PCCSC Qualifier for the ICSA Men's & Women's Single-Handed National Championship. The number of advancing teams is determined by the ICSA Championship Berth Allocations

BOATS

Participants are responsible for providing their own class legal Lasers and sails. Male competitors are expected to provide their own Laser class sailboats. Female competitors are expected to provide their own Laser Radial class sailboats. Women will be sailing with Radial sails and men will be sailing with Standard sails.

LOCATION

Treasure Island Sailing Center

DIRECTIONS

From San Francisco or points on the west side of San Francisco Bay:

- Take I-80 East to the Bay Bridge. Treasure Island is a left exit at the end of the San Francisco side span. The exit road will merge onto the road that runs down the west side of Yerba Buena Island (overlooking San Francisco to the west and Clipper Cove to the east). Continue down the hill until you reach the gate that guards the entrance to Treasure Island.
- Continue through the gate and take your first right onto California Ave.
- As you proceed down California, you will see several large buildings on your right. After the last building, turn right on Avenue "I". Drive straight (south) along the building to the facility.

From Oakland or points on the east side of San Francisco Bay:

- Take I-80 west to the Bay Bridge. After the toll booths, merge into the far right lane. The exit for Yerba Buena/Treasure Island is a right exit at the end of the Oakland side span. Follow the exit road around to the west side of Yerba Buena Island. At the stop sign merge onto the road that takes you down to the gates of Treasure Island. Continue through the gate and take your first right onto California Ave.
- As you proceed down California, you will see several large buildings on your right. After the last building, turn right on Avenue "I". Drive straight (south) along the building to the facility.

HOUSING

COURSES

A Course Chart will be provided with the Sailing Instructions and will describe the marks and courses, the order in which marks are to be rounded or passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

SCORING

The scoring system will follow the ICSA procedural rules.

PROTESTS

Decisions that the Protest Committee makes are final. The right of appeal is denied at all Conference Championships.
