4 Format

- 4.1 There may be three A division races followed by three B races. If conditions are good the sets will be just two races each with two sets per division for a total of eight races. No boat rotation.
- 4.2 If 12 or fewer teams compete, the format will be changed to combined divisions with as many as five races.

5 Courses

- 5.1 Apex 2 Reaching start down through to gate, through bottom gate, through top gate, finish left.
- 5.2 Apex 3 Same as Apex 2 but with three legs finishing through bottom gate.
- 5.3 Apex 4 Same as Apex 2 but twice around or four legs.

6 Equipment

- 6.2 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites are beautiful; keep them that way.
- 6.1 Flashlights will be provided.

7 Coaching Tips

- 7.1 Start where the others are not.
- 7.2 Never get fouled by any other boat.
- 7.3 At a crowded rounding, it's better to use speed on the outside rather than yelling on the inside.

8 Parking, etc.

- 8.1 Parking is plentiful and easy next to the boathouse but do not park in handicapped spaces.
- 8.2 Food is allowed on the third floor but gear bags are not.
