1 Rules

2 Schedule

- **4 Format** will be combined divisions with 20 Larks racing at once.

5 Courses

- 5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate).
- 5.2 Course 5 (W-L-W-L-W with offset and gate) may be used as well.
- 5.3 Course 6 is also a possibility.
- 5.4 If windy enough, G (W-R-R-W-L) or O (W-R-R-W-L-W) may be used with no offset nor gate.

6 Equipment

Turbo Larks, outfitted with square-head mains and tapered masts, enable a lower wind minimum and provide college sailing's only high-performance racing experience. Adjusting shroud pins between races is permitted, under the condition that sailors will be expected to provide their own replacement pins if any pins are dropped overboard.

7 Protests

- 7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.
- 7.2 Protests will be heard in the Crystal Lake Room (conference room).
- **8 Prizes** for all is the opportunity to sail the coolest boats in all of college sailing.

9 Boathouse Use

- 9.1 Gear bags and changing of clothes are not allowed on the top floor.
- 9.2 Food is allowed on the top floor but be neat.
- **10 Parking** is plentiful, just be sure you are in a legal space, not a handicap space.
