- 3 Sailing Instructions will be available via Tech Score by Thursday at 1800
- 4 FORMAT 4.1 Racing will be held concurrently on the same course. The regatta format will be a single round robin
- 4.2 A Division shall start racing on the dock, then race a set in FJs, then race a set in Fireflies.
 - B Division shall start racing in Fireflies, then have a set on the dock, then race a set in FIs
 - C Division shall start racing in FJs, then race a set in Fireflies, then have a set on the dock.
- 5 RACING AREA 5.1 The racing area will be the Lower Charles River Basin.
- 6 ROTATION 6.1 The rotation of boats will be in accordance with the provided rotation sheet available at the competitors' meeting and on tech score. Competitors may only pull up boats on the dock during the rotation period with the permission of the race committee. Please ease the gnav or vang between races and do not land at the dock during a set.

7 COURSES 7.1 Outer and Inner trapezoids will be used as diagrammed in the sailing instructions

8 COACHING 8.1 ICSA PR 19 will apply, and all Coaches shall remain ashore. Northeastern coaches may coach from the RC boat between races when they are serving as RC.

9 NEISA REPRESENTATIVE 9.1 The Race Committee shall appoint a Representative who shall assist in ensuring the quality and fairness of the competition. This representative shall act as a liaison between the teams in attendance and the Race Committee Chairman.
