



SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Owlapalooza 2019

November 16, 2019

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta shall be governed by the current (2013-2016) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ICSA Procedural Rules (PR), ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, the PCCSC Standing Rules, and the Notice of Race, except as modified by these Sailing Instructions.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1. Notices will be posted on the official regatta notice board located on the Seahorse porch.

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. Any changes in the sailing instructions will be announced orally and posted before the first race in which they are to take effect.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1. The one-day regatta will be held on Saturday, November 16. The skippers meeting will be at 0900, with the first race starting at 1000.

5. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

- 5.1. Bay Access Sailing Foundation's fleet of Flying Junior (FJ) class boats will be provided for competitors, who shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way. Competitors have the option of rigging the mainsheet purchase either 3:1 or 4:1.
- 5.2. The standing rigging shall not be adjusted.
- 5.3. Competitors shall report any damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the boat repair committee immediately after arriving ashore or to the Race Committee on the water.

6. ROTATION

- 6.1. The rotation of boats will be in accordance with the provided rotation sheet.

7. THE COURSE

- 7.1. The courses will be announced orally and taken from the course diagrams on the official regatta notice board.

8. SAFETY

- 8.1. Competitors who require assistance from rescue boats should so signify by waving arms overhead. A competitor who retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

9. COACHING

- 9.1. ICSA PR 19 shall apply.

10. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

- 10.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

11. LAKEWOOD YACHT CLUB PRESCRIPTIONS

- 11.1. Competitors shall abide by all LYC club rules as available in the LYC office.
