

Sailing Instructions – Amendment 1

Sections 5.1 and 5.2 of the sailing instructions shall be changed to read as follows:

5.1 A and B fleets will sail in a standard 2 division format.

5.2 Rotation will occur after every 2 races sailed.

Section 6.2 shall be added as follows:

6.2 A second course shall be used if winds are judged to be strong enough to facilitate hydroplaning. This course will utilize mark “2” as a reaching mark instead of a windward offset. Rather than incorporating a gate, this course will use mark “G” as a single leeward mark to be left to port. Sailors shall observe the reach mark on each lap of the course. If mark “G” is placed roughly on the starting line, sailors shall proceed directly from the reach mark (“2”) to the finish on the final lap. Alternatively, Mark “G” may be moved to a position significantly to leeward of the starting line, and thereafter shall be observed on the final lap, requiring sailors to finish on a beat to windward.
