

# Sailing Instructions



## UCSD Frosh Soph and Open Regattas UC San Diego Sailing Team at Mission Bay Yacht Club October 19-20, 2019

### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by: the ICSA Procedural Rules 2017-2020 including the Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules; the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing; the Prescriptions of US SAILING; the PCCSC Standing Rules, the Notice of Race, and these Sailing Instructions. In the event of a disagreement between the NOR and these SI's, the SI's will take precedence.

### 2. Notice to Competitors

Notices, scores, and changes will be announced verbally at the rotation area or competitors meetings.

### 3. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole by the Junior Yacht Club and communicated verbally.

### 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

### 5. Racing Area

The racing area will be Mission Bay. Further description will be given at the competitors meeting.

### 6. Courses

Courses will either be windward-leeward courses of 2, 3, 4 or 5 legs, signified by W2, W3, W4, or W5, respectively depending on the wind conditions. Courses may have gates. The course number will be signified aboard the race committee boat both verbally and visually before the beginning of each start sequence.

### 7. Marks

Frosh Soph and Open will share the same course.

**8. Starts and Finishes**

Start and finish lines will be between a buoy and an orange flag on the RC boat. Boats that cross this line when not starting or finishing shall be scored DNF without a hearing. The starting sequence shall be as described in Appendix S, with the warning given 3 minutes before the start.

**9. OCS**

The RC may attempt to hail the sail number of a boat OCS, but failure to receive or hear this hail shall not be grounds for redress. It is each boat's responsibility to start correctly.

**10. Change of Course**

The RC may move any mark of the course without signal before a boat has rounded the previous mark.

**11. Time Limits**

There will be no time limit. However, the RC may choose to finish boats 'on the course' if their position in the race has been established in order to expedite the next start or rotation.

**12. Protests and Redress**

Open protests and request for redress must be filed within 30 minutes of the race committee's return to the dock. Forms will be available at the on shore. Frosh Soph protest shall be heard using the 3 minute justice system. Results of Frosh Soph protests must be reported to the host school immediately. All boats must notify the RC of their intent to protest immediately following the finish of the race in which the incident occurred.

**13. Scoring**

Scoring shall be completed as described in the Procedural Rules.

**14. Record of Participation**

RP forms must be completed online at [ts.collegesailing.org](http://ts.collegesailing.org) before 0800 on Monday October 14, 2019.

**15. Disclaimer of Liability**

Participants in this event compete entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
