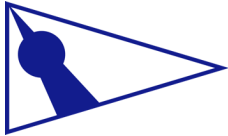

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Severn Sailing Association & US Naval Academy

November 6-7



1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta shall be governed by the current (2021-2024) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ICSA Procedural Rules (PR), ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, 2021 General Conditions for the ICSA Championships, the ILCA Class Rules, and the Notice of Race, except as modified by these Sailing Instructions. ICSA PR 32 shall be in effect.
- 1.2. If there is a contradiction between the ILCA Class Rules and the ICSA Procedural Rules, the ICSA Procedural Rules shall take precedence.
- 1.3. PR 22.b.i is deleted.
- 1.4. Compasses that are compliant with ILCA Class Rule 22 shall be permitted for this event.
- 1.5. ILCA Class Rule 4 is deleted.
- 1.6. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Intercollegiate Sailing Association and the Severn Sailing Association.
- 1.7. Although boats are not supplied by the OA, breakdowns shall be handled in accordance with PR 20. This changes RRS 62.1.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1. Notices will be posted on the Notice Board on Techscore.

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. Any changes in the Sailing Instructions will be announced orally and posted before the first race in which they are to take effect.

5. FORMAT

- 5.1. The format for the championship shall be as prescribed in the Conditions for the 2021 Intercollegiate Singlehanded National Championship.

6. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

- 6.1 This is a bring your own boat event, there will be no rotation of boats.

7. THE COURSE

- 7.1. The courses will be announced orally and taken from the Course Diagrams on the Notice Board.
- 7.2. Weather marks will be orange cylinders, and the gate marks will be orange tetrahedrons.
- 7.3. The race course location will be announced each morning.

8. START/FINISH

- 8.1. Races will be started in accordance with PR 18(b)(i).
- 8.2. The start line will be between an orange flag on the Race Committee Boat and an orange flag on a pin boat or a yellow ball.
- 8.3. The finish line will be between an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and a nearby orange ball.

9. REQUESTS FOR HEARINGS

- 9.1. Requests for Hearings shall be filed in accordance with the ICSA Procedural Rules.
- 9.2. Requests for Hearings shall be filed within 20 minutes of boats returning to shore for a break in racing after the race or set of races in which the incident occurred. This changes PR 30.
- 9.3. Request for Hearing forms will be available with the Jury Secretary upstairs of SSA in the Great Room.
- 9.4. Hearings will take place at SSA upstairs in the Jr. Sailing Classroom.
- 9.5. Boats (and their witnesses) may not present video, data and/or photographic evidence in Hearings. This changes RRS 63.6.
- 9.6. The posting of the Hearing Schedule of a Request for Redress is considered to meet US Sailing prescription to rule 63.2. Requests may be made orally to the Protest Committee when the hearing is called. This changes RRS 63.2(c)(2).

10. COACHING

- 10.1. Coach boats will be provided by the OA.
- 10.2. While boats are racing, coach boats shall remain in the designated coaching zone unless otherwise directed by the OA.

11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

- 11.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the OA and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

12. CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 12.1. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment as specified by the OA.

13. DRONES and U.A.V.s

- 13.1 U.A.V. / Drone operation is prohibited by anyone other than the Organizing Authority or media partners in the race area on November 6 and 7, 2021.
