1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Rules, and the sailing instructions.

3 Sailing Instructions

Will be posted via Tech Score by Friday.

4 Format

4.1 A and B fleets will switch on the dock every 2 races.

4.2 No rotation of boats; teams shall sail the same boat throughout the regatta.

5 Courses

5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate).

5.2 Courses 5 and 6 may be used as well. For course 5, the finish is between mark 1 and the committee boat.

5.4 In the event of strong winds, additional courses incorporating reach legs may be posted on the notice board.

6 Equipment

6.1 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites, are beautiful; keep them that way.

6.2 Adjusting the shroud pins between races is permitted except that no spare clevis pins and cotter rings will be supplied if they are dropped off the dock.

7 Protests

7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.

7.2 Protests may be heard in the Crystal Lake Room (conference room), or outdoors.

8 Prizes

All participants will be awarded with the opportunity to sail the fastest boats in all of college sailing.

9 Boathouse Use

9.1 The boathouse is off limits to competitors, except to use the bathroom with a mask.

10 Parking

There is adequate public parking, but be sure you are in a legal space.
