**1 Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules, and the sailing instructions.

**2 Schedule**

Saturday report time	1030
Competitors Meeting	1045
First start Saturday	1120
Sunday report time	0930
First start Sunday	1020
No Sunday start after	1500

Note: the boathouse will not open before 1000 for early arrivals. Early arrivals can help carry boats out.

**3 Sailing Instructions** will be available via Tech Score by Friday.

**4 Format**

Continuous sets of two races each, first for A, then alternating.

**5 Courses**

- 5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)
- 5.2 Course 5 (W-L-W-L-W with offset and gate) may be used as well and course 6 is also a possibility.
- 5.4 If windy enough, G (W-R-R-W-L) with the "F" finish flag as the leeward mark.

**6 Larks**

Built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites. Adjusting the shroud pins between races is permitted except that no spare clevis pins and cotter rings will be supplied if you lose any.

**7 Protests**

- 7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.
- 7.2 Protests will be heard in the Crystal Lake Room (conference room)

**8 Prizes** for all is the opportunity to sail the coolest boats in all of college sailing.

**9 Boathouse Use**

- 9.1 Gear bags and changing of clothes are not allowed on the top floor.
- 9.2 Food is allowed on the top floor but be neat.

**10 Parking** is plentiful, just be sure you are in a legal space, not a handicap space.
