1 Rules

4 Format

A and B fleets will rotate on the dock every 2 races.

5 Courses

- 5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)
- 5.2 Course 5 (W-L-W-L-W with offset and gate) may be used as well.
- 5.3 Course 6 is also a possibility
- 5.4 Mark 2 May be used as a reach mark in the event of strong winds

6 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites are beautiful; keep them that way. Adjusting the shroud pins is NOT permitted.

7 Protests

- 7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.
- 7.2 Protests will be heard in the Crystal Lake Room (conference room)

8 Prizes for all is the opportunity to sail the coolest boats in all of college sailing.

9 Boathouse Use
