Amendment to the Sailing Instruction Paragraph 11

**11 PROTESTS**

- 11.1 Protests shall be filed in accordance with the ICSA Procedural Rules except as modified by these sailing instructions.
- 11.2 Competitors intending to file shall report it to the finish boat immediately after finishing.
- 11.3 Protest forms shall be completed and the other party or parties shall be verbally notified within 15 minutes of securing boats to the shore after the set of races in which the incident occurred. Protest forms will be available *from the counter in the lower lobby of the sailing pavilion*.
- 11.4 The protesting party shall then find an uninterested sailor from their division and one impartial coach to hear the protest.
- 11.5 The protested boat shall also find one uninterested sailor from their division to hear the protest.
- 11.6 Hearings shall be convened immediately and shall be open for all competitors to observe silently.
- 11.7 Deliberations may be private among jury members.
- 11.8 Decisions shall be made in writing on the form and the form should be submitted to the score keeper at the computer in the upstairs office area immediately after the hearing.
- 11.9 Video, data and/or photographs taken from any source may be presented as evidence at protest hearings.
