SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the current version of the Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024), including Appendix D, the Procedural Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition, and the Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, except as any of these are modified by these Sailing Instructions.

2. NOTICES to COMPETITORS

Notices will be posted on the official regatta Notice Board located online on Techscore.

3. CHANGES in SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes in the sailing instructions will be announced orally and posted before the first race in which they are to take effect.

4. SCHEDULE of EVENTS

 5:00pm No starting signal after

5. FORMAT

Racing will be combined divisions. Rotations will be after 3 races. 1 single round robin planned (10 races maximum). 3 races constitute a regatta.

6. BOATS

20 Laser Performance FJ's will be used. Competitors are to report any damage or equipment failures to the Race Committee as soon as practicable.

7. RACING AREA

Racing will take place either in Bayboro Harbor or Tampa Bay, east of Lassing Park. A 150 foot restriction zone must be maintained from the Coast Guard base as well as a 40 foot distance from boats in the Harborage Marina.

8. MARKS

All marks will be orange balls.

9. COURSES

Courses will be W3, W4, or W5, including a weather mark, offset mark, and leeward gate. Finishes will be between an RC boat displaying a blue flag and either the start mark or the windward mark.
