

2022 Women's ACC Series, Round 1A Information for Competitors

Parking

On-street parking, metered [on Saturday] parking is available on the westbound side of Memorial Drive. The on-street westbound parking is free on Sunday. Additional parking in paid lots and garages can be found on any mapping app and is generally located 1-4 blocks north of Memorial Drive.

Field of Play/Spectators

The entire Harvard Boathouse, including all docks and indoor spaces, is considered a "Field of Play" area and is reserved for competing sailors & reserves, coaches, regatta officials/volunteers, and competing teams' school officials. Spectators are welcome to enjoy excellent views of racing along the wide sidewalk on Memorial Drive. Sailors wishing to spend time with spectators at the event should do so outside of the Harvard Boathouse, along the sidewalk on Memorial Drive.

Restrooms

The downstairs restroom in the Harvard Boathouse is designated a coed bathroom for this event – please knock before entering. Additional restrooms are available directly across Memorial Drive in the MIT Sloan building.

Launching & Storing of Boats

Upon rigging/launching, boat covers must be tied down to docks or cradles. Sails are stored in the boats, rolled separately. Covers get put on before boats get tied down. Tie boats down over the covers and *through the u-bolt* that the shrouds attach to, *not around* the shroud plate/u-bolt.

Boat Repairs

Please report any necessary boat repairs to the RC (upon finishing, etc) or to Boston College sailors on the Harvard docks or in the Boathouse.

Protests/Jury Secretary

Protest forms will be available on the counter directly across from the bottom of the stairs. Protests forms should be delivered to the RC if available or to Harvard Coach Eli Burns.
