



**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**PACIFIC COAST FALL DINGHY CHAMPIONSHIP**  
**Santa Barbara Yacht Club**  
**November 18-19, 2023**



**RULES:** This regatta shall be governed by rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the ICSA Procedural Rules, and the PCCSC Standing Rules.

**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:** The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with the Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC).

**HOST TEAM:** UC Santa Barbara Sailing Team

**FORMAT:** The Pacific Coast Fall Dinghy Championship will be a 3-division non-rotational event sailed in CFJ's. Teams are required to provide two (2) boats and two (2) sets of PCCSC class legal sails with PCCSC assigned sail number ([http://pccsc.collegesailing.org/documents/pccsc\\_standing\\_rules\\_sail\\_numbers.pdf](http://pccsc.collegesailing.org/documents/pccsc_standing_rules_sail_numbers.pdf)). Two divisions will be on the water, while one is on land. A schedule of starts will be included as an attachment to the Sailing Instructions.

The Jr. Varsity Fall Dinghy Champs will be a 2-division non-rotational event sailed in CFJ's. Teams are required to provide their own boats with PCCSC approved sails.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All PCCSC Regular, Provisional, and Associate Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail. A maximum of one (1) coed varsity team and one (1) women's team per school will be allowed in the Pacific Coast Fall Dinghy Championship and unlimited teams will be allowed in the Jr. Varsity PCC's. As per the PCCSC Standing Rules, all competitors are required to wear their school pinnies. Sailors must meet all ICSA eligibility requirements and may be required to verify enrollment at the school they are representing.

**ENTRY:** Eligible teams must notify the host school and the Conference Commissioner five (5) days prior to the event with their intent to participate. **FEES:** There is \$50 per varsity team entry fee payable to 'UCSB Sailing Team'.

**CHARTERS:** A limited number of charter CFJ's will be available and will be distributed based on distance traveled, then order of request at a price of \$50 per day (not including sails). **QUALIFICATION:** This event shall serve as the PCCSC Qualifier for the Rose Bowl Interconference Regatta hosted by USC in January. The top 15 PCCSC teams (counting the scores from the varsity A and B divisions) will be offered

berths at the Rose Bowl. This event shall also serve as the fall ranking regatta and finishes will be used to determine interconference regatta selection rankings for 2024.

**VENUE:** The sailing venue will be announced at the Competitor Meeting. The location for boat storage for the weekend is at the boat launch ramp area and shown in 'Attachment P - Parking'.

**DOCUMENTATION:** Record of Participation (RP) forms must be completed online at [ts.collegesailing.org](http://ts.collegesailing.org) by midnight.

**PROTESTS & APPEALS:** In accordance with rule 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted. If the requirements are not met, the decisions of the protest committee may be appealed.

**SAFETY:** A U.S. Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type III, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.

From SF: Take US 101 South to Santa Barbara

Exit Castillo St, turn Right, get in the center lane

Turn Right onto Cabrillo Blvd

Turn Left onto Harbor Way

Bear Left immediately into public parking

Proceed along the harbor past 2 gates to the Launch Ramp
