1 Rules

The Regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the *ICSA Procedural Rules*.

2 Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board upstairs.

4 Format

- 4.1 Round one is a double round-robin for all six teams.
- 4.2 If time permits, round three will split the fleet into silver and gold groups with sizes determined based on the proximity of scores.
- 4.3 Rotate boats after each round

5 The Course

The course will be a digital “N” as described in the *ICSA Procedural Rules*.

6 Marks

All turning marks are mast buoys displaying numbered flags, 1-4.

7 The Start

Races will be started using Appendix Q, Sound Signal Starting System. Starts may be rolling for up to three starts in a row.

The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starboard end committee boat and flag buoy “S” at the port end.

8 The Finish

The finishing line will be between an orange flag on the starboard end committee boat and flag buoy “F” at the port end. Alternatively, if no finish boat is in place, the plastic jugs attached to the anchor will serve as the starboard end of the finish line, with a free-floating mark boat sighting the finish.

9 Protests

Protest forms are available in the office/kitchenette on the top floor. Competitors shall

notify the finish boat of their intent to protest immediately following the finish of the 6th place boat in their race. Protest forms shall be filed with the scorekeeper within 20 minutes of the end of any round-robin or sail-off round.
