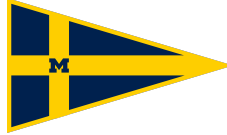


# 2023 MCSA Open & Women's Singlehanded Championship

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Midwest Collegiate Sailing Association (MCSA), University of Michigan, and Crescent Sail Yacht Club.
- 1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3. The US Sailing prescription to 63.2 shall not apply.
- 1.4. The ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules and MCSA Policies shall apply. **Competitors are strongly encouraged to review these Rules and Policies prior to the event.**
- 1.5. For MCSA Championships the Conditions for ICSA Championships shall be used. They can be found at this link: <https://collegesailing.org/documents/ICSA-DRAFT-New-Conditions.pdf>
- 1.6. This Notice of Race (NOR), except as modified by the Sailing Instructions, shall apply.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All Teams must be members in good standing of the ICSA and are scheduled to participate in the event at the Annual meeting or after that by the MCSA Regatta Coordinator.
- 2.2. All regatta team members participating must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. [See PR 12]
- 2.3. Student-athletes shall register annually with ICSA prior to competing.
- 2.4. All Student-athletes shall register online using Techscore <https://ts.collegesailing.org/>.
- 2.5. A representative from each competing team shall enter completely on the Record of Participation Form online with Techscore or in person, the **names** and **class years** of all **skippers** and **crews** who competed, as well as the **races** in which they competed.
- 2.6. A team failing to properly complete the Record of Participation Form before the expiration of protest time at the end of the regatta, shall be rescored according to PR 33(a) for fleet racing and PR 33(b) for team or match racing (see also PR Appendix C - ICSA FORMS).
- 2.7. The two-week drop deadline for this event is September 1st.
- 2.8. The 24-hour drop deadline is 12 noon on the Friday before the event (September 15th).
- 2.9. To drop a berth for this event, contact the MCSA Regatta Coordinator. Drop deadline penalties can be found in the MCSA Policies.
- 2.10. Regatta fees of \$10 will be charged.

### 3. SCHEDULE AND NUMBER OF RACES

- 3.1. There shall be a maximum of 14 races sailed. The target time for each race shall be 25 minutes. There will be no rotations. This changes PR 22.b.i.

**4. BOATS AND EQUIPMENT**

- 4.1 Collegiate Dinghies (ILCA 6/7) are to be provided by the competitor.
- 4.2 Boats, equipment and rigging shall comply with ILCA Class rules and requirements.
- 4.3 Borrowed boats shall be considered "personal equipment". Per the Championship Conditions: "8.4 PR20 shall apply to equipment, supplied by the host or OA, but does not include personal equipment".
- 4.4 The Open division will be sailed on ILCA 7 boats.
- 4.5 The Women's division will be sailed on ILCA 6 boats.

**5. TEAM UNIFORMS**

- 5.1 All student-athletes competing in ICSA regattas shall wear a uniform designating their college.
- 5.2 The uniform shall be a lightweight jersey, bib, or pinnie worn over a PFD, or like-colored PFD.
- 5.3 To designate the college, any combination of the college's name, nickname, mascot, or other identifying image shall be present on the back of the uniform and, except for an individual's name or number, shall be the same for all team members competing. [See PR 13(e)]

**6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting, online at the event website ([scores.collegesailing.org](https://scores.collegesailing.org)), on the official notice board and on the [MCSA Schedule](#).

**7. RACING AREA**

The racing area will be on the waters of Lake St. Clair. The CSYC Gate PIN is 23915.

**8. SPECTATORS**

- 8.1. All spectators shall remain at least 100 yards from the competitors while racing. Spectators shall receive 1 warning upon entering the "field of play." The second entrance shall be cause for a protest by the OA against the affiliated team(s) under RRS 41.
- 8.2. Spectator boats shall not dock in areas that interfere with the function of the sailboat rotation area.

**9. TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded to competitors that place in the following places (1st in each division).

**10. PHOTOGRAPHY, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT**

- 10.1. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment, or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority (OA).
- 10.2. Individuals and their teams are permitted to use personal video/film/camera or sound recording equipment on their boats, however, the video and audio obtained by their personal cameras may not be used during a protest hearing. Video/film/camera equipment includes, but is not limited to, GoPro and other action cameras, U.A.V.s, and Drones.

**11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
