Savin Hill YC Housekeeping

- BC Sailing is a member of Savin Hill YC. Visiting sailors are YC guests. Please respect and follow any instructions from all YC members and employees at all times.
- The YC is a locked facility – if you must leave to go your car briefly, the exit doors can be hooked/propped temporarily. If you must leave for a longer period of time, contact teammates to be let back in. Avoid ringing doorbells
- Teams are encouraged to change clothes in their vehicles or upstairs in the function room. Dry base layers can be changed in the bathrooms.
- ***All gear (bags, food, life jackets, etc) should be stored in team vehicles.***
- Please remove wet layers before entering the clubhouse.

Boats

- The 420s are new and should be in perfect working order
- See BC sailors and RC/Coach with any boat issues
- Tie your sailbags to the dock!
- Do not put rudders on while boats are on the dock – only put rudders on when boats are in the water
- The rudders are hard to get on/off – use your bailer to get the gudgeons and pintles wet, it helps a little
- LIFT the boats out of the water at the end of the day
- Tie the boats down at the bow and the sidestays – and pull them up enough that people can walk behind them

Venue

- Stay in the channel on the way to the race course – beware of boat traffic and make it easy for larger boats to use the channel

Format

- Dress immediately upon arrival and proceed to docks for ride to boats and launching – there will be no competitors meeting
- There will be no rotation and no extended lunch break (the lunch break/rest period will occur at the end of racing)
- There will be one 5-minute break can come to land and use the bathroom and make substitutions
