Sailing Instructions

1. RULES

1.1. If there is a contradiction between the ILCA Class Rules and the ICSA Procedural Rules, the ICSA Procedural Rules shall take precedence.
1.2. Compasses that are compliant with ILCA Class Rule 22 shall be permitted for this event.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1. Notices will be posted on the Notice Board on Techscore.

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Any changes in the Sailing Instructions will be announced verbally and posted before the first race in which they are to take effect.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5. FORMAT

5.1. There shall be a maximum of 14 races sailed. The target time for each race shall be 25 minutes. There will be no rotation. This changes PR 22.b.i.

6. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

6.1. Boats, spars, and sails are to be chartered through Zim Sailing. Additional equipment is to be supplied by the competitors

7. THE COURSE

7.1. The courses will be announced verbally and taken from the Course Diagrams on the Notice Board.

7.2. All course marks will be orange inflatable balls.

8. START/FINISH

8.1. The start line will be between orange staffs between Race Committee Boats at each end of the starting line.

8.2. The finish line will be between a blue staff on the Race Committee boat and a nearby yellow inflatable located to windward of the Race Committee boat.

8.3. The starting order for each fleet will be announced orally from the Race Committee Boat. It is the intention to have the ILCA 7 fleet start first, with the ILCA 6 fleet to start second.

9. REQUESTS FOR HEARINGS

9.1. Requests for Hearings shall be filed within 30 minutes of the last boat returning to shore for a break in racing after the race or set of races in which the incident occurred. This changes PR 30.

9.2. Request for Hearing forms will be available on the cork board located in Bay 1 of the sailing center.

9.3. Hearings will take place at the SPSC.

9.4. Video, data and/or photographs taken from any source shall not be presented by the competitors as evidence at protest hearings. This changes RRS 63.6

10. COACHING

10.1. Coaching will be from boats to be provided by the OA. Each school shall be permitted 1 coach per fleet on the water.

10.2. Coach boats shall remain in the designated coaching zone unless otherwise directed by the OA.
