

North/North Regatta November 2/3, 2024 Husky Sailing Sail Sand Point



1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ICSA procedural rules, this Notice of Race, and Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

This regatta is open to schools which are registered and in good standing with PCCSC and ICSA. A school may bring one coed varsity team and one women's varsity team. A school may also bring unlimited JV teams. Each team shall consist of four or more currently eligible sailors from the same college/university.

3. REGISTRATION & FEES

Teams shall RSVP to the regatta by 8:00 pm Monday, October 30th, 2024. Teams shall RSVP using the online <u>PCCSC Live Schedule</u>. An entry fee of \$30 per team will be collected at registration on Saturday morning. Teams may venmo @UW-Sailing or make out a check to the "Husky Sailing Team".

4. BOATS & FORMAT

This will be a two-division (A & B Fleet) regatta sailed in FJs. Varsity and JV will race in the same fleet and will be scored separately. There will be A and B rotations. There are limited charters available through Husky Sailing. These will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and priority will be given to teams traveling a further distance. The charter fee is \$50 per day. Teams that charter are responsible for providing their own sails, and are expected to return borrowed equipment in good working order. Teams able to bring their own boats are encouraged to do so.

5. VENUE

Racing will take place in front of Sail Sand Point (7861 62nd Ave NE, Seattle, WA 98115). Rotations will occur off the concrete dock. The competitors meeting and check-in will both take place in front of the main office. Parking for cars and trailers (including overnight) is available on site free of charge.

6. LAUNCHING & BOAT STORAGE

Teams are encouraged to launch their boats prior to the competitors' meeting. Trailers and dollies may be stored adjacent to the launch ramp during racing. Boats will need to be stored on dollies and parked in a designated area overnight.
