- 4 Format
- 4.1 This is a one-division, no-boat-rotation event sailed in Rhodes-19s.
- 4.2 Teams can sail with two or three sailors in their boat
- 5 Courses
- 5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)
- 5.2 Course 3 or 5 is a possibility
- 5.3 Courses will be set in the vicinity of Pier 4, near where Courageous is located.
- 6 Starts will use the three-minute sound system
- 7 Protests
- 7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first opportunity after the incident.
- 8 Prizes will be awarded to the winning team and possibly to the next two teams as well.
- 9 Safety
- 9.1 All sailors are warned that there is considerable commercial and recreational traffic in Boston Harbor
- 9.2 All large commercial vessels have right-of-way
- 10 Location/Parking: The regatta will be sailed from Courageous Sailing, on Pier 4 in the Charlestown Navy Yard. Parking is available on Pier 3. Pier 3 is also known as Baxter Road;

use "DC Beane," the construction company, as the address. Parking is available on Pier 3 facing the water, not against the building. It's a five minute walk to Pier 4. Check in will be on the left side of the white boathouse with a flag on top.
