RULES:

- **1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules and the Sailing Instructions.
- **1.2.** The Organizing Authority is SAISA in conjunction with Jacksonville University ELIGIBILITY:
- 2.1. Any SAISA school that is in good standing with SAISA and ICSA.
- 2.2. Any team may bring a maximum of 4 boats.

ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

- **4.1** All boats in the Women's Championship must be Radial Rig Lasers following all ILCA6 class rules. Open Championship must be Full Rig Lasers following all ILCA7 class rules.
