

## Information for Competitors – 2024 Savin Hill Invite

### Savin Hill YC Housekeeping

- BC Sailing is a member of Savin Hill YC. Visiting sailors are YC guests. Please respect and follow any instructions from all YC members and employees at all times.
- The YC is a locked facility – if you must leave to go your car briefly, the exit doors can be hooked/propped temporarily. If you must leave for a longer period of time, contact teammates to be let back in. Avoid ringing doorbells
- It is best to arrive wearing your base layers and to put on your sailing gear at your vehicle. You can also change clothes upstairs in the shed (men) or the function room (women). At the end of the day, please remove wet outer layers outdoors before entering the function room.
- ***All gear (bags, food, etc) should be stored in team vehicles.***
- Please remove wet layers before entering the clubhouse.

### Boats

- See BC sailors and RC/Coach with any boat issues
- Tie your sailbags to the dock!
- Do not put rudders on while boats are on the dock – only put rudders on when boats are in the water
- LIFT the boats out of the water at the end of the day
- Tie the boats down at the bow and the sidestays – and pull them up enough that people can walk behind them

### Venue

- Stay in the channel on the way to the race course – beware of boat traffic and make it easy for larger boats to use the channel

- Dress immediately upon arrival; be ready to go to your boats at 10:40a
- There will be no rotation
- Each division will have a 10-minute break for bathroom, grabbing additional food and substitutions – this will be the only opportunity for substitutions without missing a race
- Coach boats may be provided
