RULES

The regatta will be governed by: the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules & Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules and the Sailing Instructions.

ENTRY

Each school may enter one coed varsity team, one women's varsity team, and unlimited JV teams. This will be a 2 divisional rotational event.

There is a \$50 entry fee per boat payable by cash or check to "UC Regents - Cal Sailing". Entry fees will be collected at the event. Cash is preferred. If you cannot pay through either of these means, please let Ethan Lisle know via email (calsailing@gmail.com).

ROATS

Teams will race PCCSC-legal FJs to be provided by each team. Teams must provide their own PCCSC legal FJ sails.

Limited charter boats may be available, please contact <u>calsailing@gmail.com</u> for information. Each charter boat is \$100 for the weekend. If you are chartering, you must bring your own race sails. If there is a shortage of charters, schools traveling the largest distances will be given priority.

VENUE

Racing and staging will take place at Marina Bay Yacht Harbor. See attached image for details.

COURSES

A Course Chart will be provided with the Sailing Instructions and will describe the marks and courses, the order in which marks are to be rounded or passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

SCORING

The scoring system will follow the ICSA procedural rules.

HOUSING

The Cal Sailing Team will not be providing housing for this regatta. Teams are encouraged to stay with friends or family in the area.

WAIVER

Each sailor must complete and return the required waiver before competing on Saturday, Oct. 19th. Communication regarding waiver will be made no later than October 17th.

FACILITIES

Entry & Parking

- The Cal Sailing Team will cover the cost of 1 vehicle and trailer to enter the parking lot.
- Please park trailers in the designated spaces along the back row
- Additional personal vehicles may pay to park in the lot or utilize free street parking on Hall Ave or Marina Way South.
- Do not leave valuables in cars.
- Bathrooms are accessible inside the Marina Bay Yacht Harbor clubhouse.

Venue

- Rotations will happen from the kayak dock and launch ramp at Marina Bay Yacht Harbor.
- Do not congregate on the boat ramp.
- Be mindful and respectful of other mariners using the waterway and dock space.
- Take all your trash with you. There will be trash bins but we incur costs to use them.
- There will be viewing areas along the pier for coaches and spectators.

ELIGIBILITY

All participants in the regatta must adhere to the protocols outlined in the ICSA competition medical guidance document. Schools must submit an attestation form to the ICSA before they are allowed to compete.
