1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2025-2028), the current Intercollegiate Sailing Association (ICSA) Procedural Rules (PR), The Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, the ICSA Championship Conditions, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority is the ICSA and Old Dominion University Sailing.
- 1.3. ICSA PR 32 will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Selection of Competitors will be by conference elimination and ICSA Championship Selection Procedures as outlined in the Championship Conditions.

3. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

- 3.1. The Entry Fee is \$115 per competitor payable to the ICSA during online registration.
- 3.2. Eligible schools / sailors must enter by submitting an official online entry form and making payment. <https://collegesailing.org/machform/view.php?id=63480>
- 3.3. The entry deadline is October 28, 2025.

4. Equipment

- 4.1. The Janet Lutz Trophy will be raced in ILCA 6. The Glenn S Foster Trophy will be raced in ILCA 7. All boats must be chartered from the official supplier, Zim Sailing per the link provided.
- 4.2. Class legal ILCA 6 & 7 equipment shall be used.
- 4.3. OA provided sails shall be used.

- 4.5. ILCA Class legal electronic or analog compasses are permitted. This changes Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules 7.2
- 4.6. Boats will not be rotated.

Coaching may only take place from shore, or an OA provided boat.

Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment.

Drone operation is prohibited by anyone other than the Organizing Authority or media partners in the race area on November 8 and 9, 2025.
