NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with host University of Oregon.
- 1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements.
- 2.2. The **entry fee is \$20** payable to the treasurer at the venue the morning of the first day of the regatta, October 18th. Payable by cash, or credit card through the UO Club Sports Office (help with paying by card can be provided).
- 2.3. Registration should be made through the PCCSC Live Schedule. Unlimited boats per school allowed.

3. Schedule

Saturday, October 18th

- 8:00 - Venue Opens
- 9:15 - Report Time
- 10:00 - Competitors' Meeting
- 11:00 - First Start

Sunday, October 19th

- 10:15 - First Start
- 15:00 - No Starts After

4. Boats and Equipment

- 4.1. This is a 2 division regatta to be competed in FJs. There is no round robin boat rotation for this regatta.
- 4.2. Competing teams are responsible for bringing their own FJ's with PCCSC Legal sails OR
- 4.3. Competing teams may charter a limited number of FJ's for a **charter fee of \$50 per day**. Charters will be given to teams on a first contact, first serve basis (see contact information below).

- 4.3.1. Competitors must provide their own sails and rudders/tillers for chartered boats (exceptions can be granted).
- 4.3.2. Competitors shall not modify any chartered boat or cause them to be modified in any way.

5. Sailing Instructions

6. Venue

- 6.1. This regatta will take place on Fern Ridge Reservoir out of the Eugene Yacht Club. Bathrooms, showers, and changing facilities will be available.
- 6.2. The competitors' meeting will take place outside the EYC Youth Sailing Center.
- 6.3. Eugene Yacht Club address: 26126 Bangs Road, Junction City, OR 97448
- 6.4. Competitors are asked to respect the venue and EYC members and to not bring wet gear into the clubhouse.

7. Racing Area

- 7.1. The intended racing area will be the area just beyond the "no wake" buoys off the shore of the Eugene Yacht Club on Fern Ridge Reservoir.
- 7.2. Rotations will occur from EYC D-dock.

8. Scoring

A low point scoring system will be used in accordance with ICSA Procedural Rules.

9. Housing

- 9.1. Limited housing is available in Eugene upon request. Housing will be granted on a first contact, first served basis.
- 9.2. Camping is permitted at EYC with respect to grounds and members. Camping is also available next door at Richardson Park.
