RULES: This regatta shall be governed by rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the ICSCA Procedural Rules (PR), and the PCCSC Standing Rules.

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with the Mission Bay Yacht Club (MBYC).

HOST TEAM: San Diego State University Sailing Team (SDSU).

FORMAT: The West Coast Championship will be a 2-division rotational event sailed in provided CFJ's. One division will be on the water while one is on land.

BOATS/SAILS: Boats will be CFJ's and will provided by MBYC and sails will be provided by the UCSD sailing team.

ROTATIONS: Rotations are available at <https://scores.collegesailing.org/f25/west-coast-championships/rotations/>. Boat rotations will take place on the MBYC Junior dock.

ELIGIBILITY / ENTRY: ICSA Member Schools in good standing are eligible to enter the regatta and may enter by emailing their conference scheduler and the ICSA interconference scheduler (intersectionals@collegesailing.org). Sailors must meet all ICSA eligibility requirements. The drop deadline for the regatta is October 7, 2025. If berths are still available, they will be allocated per ICSA intersectional rules.

PROTESTS & APPEALS: In accordance with rule 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted. If the requirements are not met, the decisions of the protest committee may be appealed.

SAFETY: Competitor are reminded that PR 13 regarding personal flotation devices (PFD's) and team uniforms shall apply.
