### NOTICE OF RACE



#### 1. Rules:

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules, the Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2 Teams & Entry:

2.1 Up to seven berths are available for this event.

#### 3 Schedule:

##### **Saturday**

1030 Report Time & Boat Draw

1100 First Possible Warning Signal

1800 Last Possible Warning Signal

##### **Sunday**

0930 Report Time & Boat Draw

1000 First Possible Warning Signal

1400 Last Possible Warning Signal

#### 4 Sailing Instructions:

4.1 SI's shall be posted via Tech Score by Tuesday, March 23th.

#### 5 Format:

5.1 One division fleet racing in USCGA J/70's with crews of four.

5.2 Teams shall draw for their boat each morning of the regatta.

5.3 Up to sixteen total races are scheduled. A maximum of ten races will be sailed on Saturday.

#### 6 Courses & Racing Area:

6.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)

6.2 Course alternatives include Course 3 (W-L-W with offset and gate), Course 5 (W-L-W-L-W with offset and gate), or Course 6 (W-L-W-L-W-L with offset and gate).

6.3 The intended race duration times shall be approximately 15 to 25 minutes. This changes PR 18 (c ii).

6.4 Racing will take place on the Thames River adjacent to Jacobs Rock.

#### 7 Penalties:

7.1 RRS 44.1 is modified as follows: "A boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 while racing may take a penalty at the time of the incident. Her penalty shall be a One-Turn Penalty, unless she breaks a rule of Part 2 within the zone of any rounding mark or finishing mark, in which case her alternate penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty". This changes PR 31 (b).
