NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020), the Procedural Rules (PR) and Class Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition 2017-2020, and the NEISA Rules and Regulations, except as any of these are modified by these Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P will be in effect, as modified by PR 32.

3. FORMAT

- 3.1. A single round robin of 18 races is scheduled. Competitors will switch boats after every two races.
- 3.2. A-Division will sail FJs on Saturday and Z420s and Sunday.
- 3.3. B-Division will sail Z420s on Saturday and FJs on Sunday.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on Tech Score.

5. NEISA REPRESENTATIVE

- 5.1. Stan Schreyer (Boston University) will serve as the ICSA Representative.

6. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

- 6.1. Laser Performance FJs and Laser Performance Z420s will be provided for all competitors.

7. SAFETY

- 7.1. At the discretion of the Regatta Chairman, dry suits or wet suits may be required. Notice will be given orally and on the Official Notice Board on the morning of each day of competition.

8. COACHING

- 8.1. PR 19 will apply. Coach boats will be provided for one representative per team. All coaches must wear a Coast Guard approved PFD.

9. VENUE SPECIFIC INFO

- 9.1. The second floor of Jacobs Rock and all floating docks will be off limits to spectators.
- 9.2. Potable water will be provided. Teams do not need to bring water.
