

Pacific Coast Coed Dinghy Championships
Sailing Instructions
2018

The 2018 Coed Dinghy Championships will include 12 teams CAL, UCI, USC, Stanford, UCSC, Cal Poly, CSUMB, CSULB, CMA, UCLA, UCSB, Hawaii and be sailed on Ap. 27 & 28.

Rules: We will be sailing under the current US Sailing rules. (except as altered by the ICSA Procedural Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules and the Sailing Instructions).
Notices will be posted on the main white board at the Marine Center.

Dinghy/Format: We will attempt to sail a single round robin or until 6pm on Saturday April 28. Ties will be broken according to ICSA procedural rules. "A" Division will sail first and rotate in on the beach area marked with orange cones on the left/south side of the public boat ramp.

Course: Starting/finishing mark/pin will be a white mark and the windward/leeward gate will be orange colored.

- (1) Windward/Offset/leeward gate finish to windward (2 laps)
 - (2) Windward/Offset/Leeward gate/Windward/offset finish to leeward (1.5 laps)
 - (3) Windward/offset/Leeward gate finish to windward (1 lap)
 - (4) Triangle, windward triangle mark leeward mark (finish to windward)
- Diagrams will be provided

Protests: Follow the procedures set up in the ICSA rulebook. Protests must be filled with in 15 minutes following the set of races which the incident occurred. Protest forms can be obtained from the registration table. Protests maybe heard as soon as possible during each day. The right of appeal is denied at all Conference Championships. Decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.

Recalls: An attempt will be made to hail competitors by sail and bow #, however, it is the responsibility of the sailor to start properly.
