Notice of Race

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Rules, and the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 Drysuits with proper seals or wetsuits are suggested but not required.

2 Schedule

Sunday report time 0930
First start Sunday 1020
No Sunday start after 1500

Note: the boathouse will not open before 1000 for early arrivals on Saturday.

3 Sailing Instructions will be available via Tech Score by Friday

4 Format

“A” division will start with two races, followed by “B” division, alternating throughout.

5 Courses

- 5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)
- 5.2 Course 5 (W-L-W-L-W with offset and gate, with a finish between Mark 1 and an RC boat) may be used to facilitate easy rotation.
- 5.3 Course 6 is also a possibility

6 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites are beautiful; keep them that way. Adjusting the shroud pins between races is permitted except that no spare clevis pins and cotter rings will be supplied if you lose any.

7 Protests

- 7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.
- 7.2 Protests will be heard in the Crystal Lake Room (conference room)

8 Prizes for all is the opportunity to sail the coolest boats in all of college sailing.

9 Boathouse Use

- 9.1 Gear bags and changing of clothes are not allowed on the top floor.
- 9.2 Food is allowed on the top floor but be neat.

10 Parking is plentiful, just be sure you are in a legal space, not a handicap space.
