1 Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by The 2017 RRS and the 2017 ICSA Procedural Rules.
- 1.2 Races will not be umpired.
- 1.3 Drysuits with adequate seals or wetsuits are not required due to warm temps. However, please be aware that the water is cold.

2 Notices to Competitors

3 Schedule of Races

Report time is scheduled for 1030 Saturday Competitors meeting 1100 First warning 1130 Sunday report time 0930 No start on Sunday after 1500

4 Format

- 4.1 A round-robin of all nine teams with 36 races is planned.
- 4.2 The format thereafter depends upon timing and where to make a natural split but all races will carry forward.
- 4.3 There will be 12 Larks and 6 FJs every team will sail both Larks and FJs

5 The Course

The course will be a Starboard "N" as described in the ICSA Procedural Rules.

6 Marks

Marks are flag buoys numbered 1 (yellow), 2 (light blue), 3 (red), 4 (green), S & F (both orange).

7 The Start

- 7.1 Races will be started using Appendix Q, Sound Signal Starting System.
- 7.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the starboard end committee boat and a flag buoy at the port end.

8 The Finish

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a white flag on the starboard end committee boat and a flag buoy at the port end.

9 Protests

Protest forms are available on the table next to the RP forms. Protests shall be filed with the scorekeeper within 30 minutes of the end of any round-robin or sail-off round. Be prepared for three-minute justice with coaches and competitors as judges.
