- 3. Boats & Format: 20 FJs, A/B Divisions. Sailing Instructions will be provided on site and to all registered teams
- 4. Rotations: Depending on conditions, there will be on-the-water rotations. Further details will be provided at the Skippers Meeting. Substitutes will be ferried from shore.
- 5. Registration: All competitors must be registered with the ICSA individual directory. This is a SAISA-MAISA two-conference regatta.
- 6. Food & Water: Complimentary breakfast will be provided for all sailors/coaches on Saturday and Sunday mornings at Bow-to-Stern courtesy of the Neuse Sailing Association, the Oriental Dinghy Club, and the Sailing Club of Oriental. Teams should bring lunch and be prepared to eat during a short lunch break or on their off rotation. Please use only refillable containers for water as we strongly consider our environmental impact as a team and program. There will be stations provided to refill water bottles. Sailors and coaches participating will be treated to complimentary dinner on Saturday night at the NC BBQ & Live Band dinner at Silos/Red Rooster in Oriental.
- 7. Lodging: NC State is making arrangements to house participants in houses, with families, and in hotels during the regatta weekend. Additional lodging options include ample camping spaces. Teams are encouraged to bring spectators. It is our intention to house sailors and provide camping opportunities for spectators and others. If you would prefer to make your own housing arrangements, there are several hotels and AirBnBs available. Contact Dana if you need specific options.
