NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the 2017-2020 ICSA Procedural Rules, except any of these that are modified by this notice of race (NOR) or the sailing instructions (SI).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND FORMAT

One Coed Varsity and one Women's Varsity team may enter from each ICSA member school previously approved by the ICSA Interconference Coordinator. There will not be a JV division at this event. Depending on the number of entries, the Coed and Women's fleets may be sailed separately.

3 FEES

The entry fee is \$100 per team and may be paid via bank transfer or credit card online at www.stfyc.com.

5 EQUIPMENT

Each team shall supply their own PCCSC/CFJ class legal FJ and sails with PCCSC numbers on them. There will be no boat rotation; teams will sail their own boat for the duration of the regatta. Teams requiring charters should contact Bay Area PCCSC schools.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at or before the competitors' meeting and may also be available online at www.stfyc.com.

7 VENUE

Races will be conducted on the San Francisco City Front, either directly north of StFYC or just east of the breakwater between Fort Mason and the San Francisco Marina.

8 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward or triangle type courses.

9 SCORING

Scoring will follow 2017-2020 ICSA Procedural Rules.
