3. RACING AREA

The racing will be in the waters of Tampa Bay or the immediately adjacent Bayboro Harbor

4. BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

Teams will compete in FJ's .

5. ENVIRONMENT AND SAFETY

6.1 ISSA-PR 4.2 applies, requiring the wearing of approved PFDs.

6.3 Competitors are to use reusable water bottles. Multiple coolers of cold water will be available for refilling.

6. PARKING

Parking decals are required for parking in any student lots, including weekends. They are \$5 per day and can be purchased from the self-service kiosk in the main parking garage. There is free parking at the eastern most end of 8th avenue south, almost to the entrance to the Coast Guard base. It is about a 5-6 minute walk from that point. Metered street parking is also available but is only good for 3 hours at a time.

Teams should bring lunch and be prepared to eat on their off rotation. We have an ice machine and potable water.
