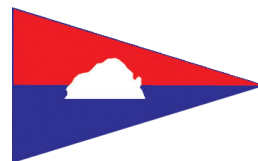

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with host, Cal Poly, SLO.
- 1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements.
- 2.2. Entry fee is **\$25** per boat payable by check made out to Cal Poly ASI
- 2.3. Teams shall confirm their participation online and with the host by 0800 the Tuesday before.
- 2.4. There will be a Varsity fleet and a JV fleet. This regatta will be a Coed 2-Division in both fleets. Schools may enter as many teams as desired in the JV fleet. Varsity fleet is limited to 2 coed boats and one women's boat. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. Teams shall confirm their participation online and with the host by 0800 the Tuesday before. Entry fees must be paid to Cal Poly Sailing Team by the 10:00 am competitors meeting.

Competing teams are responsible for bringing their own CFJ's with PCCSC Legal sails.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COMPETITORS MEETING

The competitors meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 29th on the first floor deck of Morro Bay Yacht Club. The Sailing Instructions will be available online.

6. RACING AREA

The regatta will be sailed out of the Morro Bay Yacht Club. The intended racing area will be the south basin of Morro Bay. Rotations for A and B will be held off the public dock. Parking is free and available next to the yacht club. Racing location is weather and tide permitting. Launching will occur in two places: Morro Bay

Launch ramp located on Embarcadero about 1 minute past MBYC, as well as at the MBYC crane. The launch ramp is recommended, the crane is time permitting.

7. COACHING

All coaching should be done from the public dock. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee. Coaches are not allowed on the water.

8. SCORING

Low point scoring system will be used in accordance with ICSA Procedural Rules.

9. SATURDAY DINNER

Dinner will be held inside MBYC on Saturday, February 29 immediately after racing for all participants, guests, family, and friends. Cost is \$5 per person. Please RSVP team headcount for dinner by Tuesday, February 25th. We do have a 120 person limit. Dinner fees will be collected by Cal Poly Sailing team at the door.

10. SUNDAY BREAKFAST

Pancake breakfast will be held at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday, March 1st. Breakfast is included with entry fees. Coffee, tea, hot chocolate, fruit and pancakes will be provided.

11. HOUSING

Please contact Liam Hood if you are looking for housing. MBYC members and Cal Poly team members have generously offered to provide housing for sailors; however, housing is limited.

12. CHARTERS

We have a couple boats available to charter. It will cost \$100 for the weekend and teams will still be responsible for providing sails. Contact Liam Hood to charter a boat.

13. DIRECTIONS

Take CA-1 to Morro Bay Blvd Exit Morro Bay Blvd and continue until Main St. Take a left on Main St. Take a right on Marina St Take a left on Embarcadero MBYC is on your left

14. PARKING AND BOAT STORAGE

Parking is free everywhere surrounding yacht club but limited. There is a parking lot in front of a large tin shed, directly across the street from the yacht club, you may park in. Trailers can be parked across the street from the yacht club in front of the large tin shed, in the MBYC boat yard, on any streets, and on MBYC tarmac. Boats will be stored on dollies overnight on the tarmac or in the boat yard.
