1. RULES

1.1. This regatta shall be governed by the current (2017-2020) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ICSA Procedural Rules (PR), ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, the PCCSC Standing Rules, and the Notice of Race, except as modified by these Sailing Instructions.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1. Notices will be announced orally.

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Any changes in the sailing instructions will be announced orally and posted before the first race in which they are to take effect.

5. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

5.1. Competing teams are responsible for bringing their own CFJ's with PCCSC Legal sails.

6. ROTATION

6.1. The rotations will take place at the public launch ramp docks

7. THE COURSE

7.1. The courses will be announced orally and taken from the course diagrams provided on the sailing diagrams.

8. START/FINISH

- 8.1. Races will be started in accordance with PR 18(b)(i).
- 8.2. The start line will be between a staff displaying a flag on the Race Committee Start/Finish Boat, and a nearby mark.
- 8.3. The finish line will be between a staff displaying a flag on the Race Committee Start/Finish Boat, and a nearby mark.
- 8.5 The starting line is restricted.

9. PROTESTS

- 9.1. Protests shall be filed in accordance with the ICSA Procedural Rules with the following change. "Race Committee" in PR 29(b) is changed to "Race Committee Finish Boat."
- 9.2. Written protests, including requests for redress and breakdowns, shall be filed with the scorer within 30 minutes of the last competitor's arrival ashore after the race or set of races in which the incident occurred.
- 9.3. Protest forms will be available at the LOCATION.
- 9.4. Video, data and/or photographs taken from any source shall not be used as evidence at protest hearings. This changes RRS 63.6.

10. SAFETY

10.1. Competitors who require assistance from rescue boats should so signify by waving arms overhead. A competitor who retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

11. **COACHING**


- 11.1. PR 19 will apply.
- 11.2. Coaching can be administered from the public launch ramp.


12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS
