1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS)* for 2017-2020 including Appendix D, the Intercollegiate Sailing Association Procedural Rules (ICSA PR's), and these Sailing Instructions.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official regatta notice board on Techscore (scores.collegesailing.org).

4 [NP] ASSIGNMENTS OF BOATS

Boats will be identified by their sail number.

5 FORMAT

- 5.1 The clinic will focus on team racing skills, plays, and tactics.
- 5.2 The regatta is a three-boat against three-boat team race.
- 5.3 The intended format of the regatta will be a round robin series.
- 5.4 Race Committee reserves the right to adjust the format of the regatta as needed.

6 RACING AREA

Racing will be conducted on Lake Travis from the Austin Yacht Club.

7 ROTATIONS

Rotations of boats will be completed in accordance with the rotation sheet available online on Techscore. Teams are identified by their registered team names.

8 MARKS

All marks will be either white or orange balls.

9 THE START

- 9.1 Races will be started in accordance with ICSA PR(b)(iii).
- 9.2 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the RC boat and a white or orange ball indicating the port end of the line.
- 9.3 [NP] A boat whose warning signal has not been made shall stay clear of the starting area.

10 THE COURSE

10.1 The default course is the ICSA Starboard Digital N. See Attachment A.

11 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between an orange flag on the finish boat and a white or orange ball indicating the port end of the line.

12 RECALLS

Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with ICSA PR(b)(iv).

13 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

13.1 Protests must be signaled on the water in accordance with RRS D2.2 as modified by ICSA PR 25(a).

13.2 Any protest must be registered with the finish boat upon finishing the race.

13.3 Protests will be heard on shore by a Protest Committee in accordance with ICSA PR Appendix G.

13.4 Breakdowns will be scored in accordance with RRS D5 as modified by ICSA PR 20.

14 SCORING

Boats will be scored in accordance with RRS D3 and D4 as modified by ICSA PR 25(b-d).

15 CODE OF CONDUCT

15.1 Competitors shall comply with any reasonable request from any official.

15.2 Competitors shall handle the boats and equipment with proper care and seamanship.

16 SAFETY

16.1 USCG Approved Type III PFDs shall be worn and zipped at all times while on the water.

16.2 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

17 RECORD OF PARTICIPATION (RP) FORMS

RP Forms shall be completed before the conclusion of the regatta.

18 AUSTIN YACHT CLUB PRESCRIPTIONS

18.1 No pets (except service animals), fireworks, drones, or open fires are allowed on AYC property.

18.2 AYC is committed to preventing the spread of the invasive species, zebra mussels, and asks that all boat owners (sailboats, motorboats, kayaks, etc.) clean their bilges and trailers when coming from another lake to Lake Travis, and again when leaving Lake Travis going to another lake.

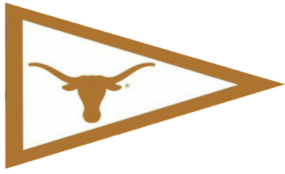
