Sailing Instructions

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Procedural Rules & Class Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition (PR) (except as any of these are modified by these sailing instructions), and by these Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS D4.3(a) and 4.3(b) are deleted and replaced as follows: "Team in a round robin shall be ranked in the order of race wins. Race results from incomplete rounds shall not be included in event scores, except that race results from incomplete rounds shall be used as sail-offs as required by PR 25(d).
- 1.3 Results from races in all rounds shall carry forward, except results from races in round robins shall not carry forward to a knockout stage.
- 1.4 All races will be umpired.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors, including boat rotations, will be posted on the official regatta notice board located on Techscore.

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes in the sailing instructions will be announced orally by the Race Committee and posted before the first race in which they are to take effect.

4. **BOATS AND EQUIPMENT**

- 4.1 Fjs will be provided for all competitors, who shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way, except that competitors may adjust lines and controls normally adjustable.
- 4.2 The standing rigging shall not be adjusted. Mainsheet may be rigged with a 3:1 or 4:1 purchase.
- 4.3 Competitors shall report any damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the the Race Committee immediately after finishing.

FORMAT

- 5.1 The intended format is a triple round robin, followed by a fourth round robin or another subsequent round or rounds.
- 5.2 The RC may change the format at any time.
- 5.3 The boat rotation is posted on the <u>"Notice Board"</u> on the Techscore site and is included as Appendix A of these SIs.

8. THE COURSE

- 8.1 The course will be a digital N.
- 8.2 Rounding marks will be faded pink balls. The starting mark will be a white ball with black stripes. The finishing mark(s) will be an orange ball with a black stripe.

9. START/FINISH

- 9.1 Races will be started in accordance with 18(b)(i).
- 9.2 The start line will be between a staff Race Committee Boat and a white mark with black stripes.
- 9.3 The finish line will be between an orange ball with a black stripe and a yellow flag on an anchored boat; or between two orange balls with black stripes.

10. RECALLS

Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with PR 18(b)(i). The Race Committee will attempt to hail the boat(s) sail number(s); however, it is the responsibility of each boat to make a proper start. Failure to hail, failure to hear a hail, any delay in haling, and the order in which boats are hailed is insufficient cause for considering redress (changes RRS 62).

11. CHANGES OF COURSE AFTER THE START

Any mark of the course may be moved in accordance with PR 18(c)(i).

14. COACHING


In accordance with PR 19, a coaches may be able to go afloat aboard safety boats.

15. SAFETY

- 15.1 A boat requesting assistance from support boats should signal by waving hands overhead.
- 15.2 A capsized boat may be righted and sailed by its crew, unless, in the sole judgment of the Race Committee, safety or the progress of the regatta would be affected, in which case the crew shall accept assistance, and the boat will be scored 'DNF.'
- 15.3 Starts may not be delayed to accommodate capsized boats.
- 15.4 A boat that retires is asked to notify the Race Committee either before leaving the course area, or immediately upon arriving ashore.


