Conditions of the 2021 Intercollegiate Sailing Men's Singlehanded Championship

1. SCHEDULING:

1.1. This event shall ordinarily be scheduled by the Board of DirectorsThe first race of the event shall be scheduled for not later than 1100 on Saturday (first day of racing). No race shall be started after 1500. on the last day.

2. ENTRANTS:

2.1. The event is open to eligible sailors representing ICSA colleges that have submitted a Declaration of Adherence on or before April 16, 2021.

3. ELIGIBILTY:

3.1. (Refer to the General Conditions for National College Sailing Championships.)

4. PARTICIPANTS:

4.1. Each team shall consist of one male. Substitutions are not permitted during the event. If a Conference is awarded more than one berth, those berths may be filled by individuals representing one or more colleges.

5. BOATS:

- 5.1. The event shall be sailed in lasers
- 5.2. Competitors shall supply their own boats.

6. REGATTA FORMAT:

The event shall be sailed in one division. There shall be a maximum of 14 races sailed. The target time for each race shall be 25 minutes for a fleet size of 25 or less. For a fleet size of 26 or greater, the target time may be increased to equal to one minute per boat, up to 40 minutes.

7. FEES:

- 7.1. A damage deposit may be assessed.
- 7.2. Entry fees may be assessed in accordance with the fee schedule in the General Conditions for National Intercollegiate Championships.

8. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

8.1. The top finisher(s) from this Championship may be invited to sail in U.S. Sailing's Singlehanded Sailing Championship--George O'Day Trophy (partial fees to be paid by ICSA).

9. TROPHIES:

- 9.1. The winner's name and college shall be engraved on the Glen S. Foster Trophy.
- 9.2. The second place person's name and college shall be engraved on the George H. Griswold Trophy.
- 9.3. Keeper trophies, provided by ICSA, shall be awarded to the top three finishers.
