

1. 8:30am zoom meeting - there should be no issues, perhaps some lingering questions. Here is the link:

2. Drop-off of sailors and gear is permissible in front of the Haney Landing Sailing Center. Maintain social distancing. Free parking is available at the east end of 8th avenue SE, just before the Coast Guard base. Day parking passes for USF lots are available at the main parking garage kiosk.

3. There are locker rooms for changing, as well as separate bathrooms, but please come essentially ready to go. There is no place to store valuables, and this is an open campus, so while duffle bags with a change of clothes would probably be fine, I would highly recommend leaving wallets and phones in your vehicles.

4. There are refillable container water stations available next to the bathrooms. Fill water containers as you will not have access to additional water until the scheduled "break".

5. Boats will have covers off, jibs up, ready to launch. Do NOT hoist mains or put rudders on until boats are in the water. Only ONE team at a time is allowed on the dock, so please launch as efficiently as possible. Be sure to use "R" clips to secure the rudders through the top pintle. Do NOT push them on past the first position.

6. 9:00 am report time at Haney Landing for all teams. Remain socially distanced until the team before you has launched, then be ready to go ASAP.

Launching order:

- College of Charleston (boats 2 and 12)
- Embry Riddle (boats 3 and 13)
- FIT (boats 4 and 14)
- Jacksonville U (boats 5 and 15)
- NC State (boats 7 and 17)
- USF (boats 6 and 16)

7. Anticipated start time of first race is by 10:00am (earlier if all teams are in the starting area). We will be sailing outside of Bayboro Harbor on Tampa Bay, directly east of Lassing Park.

8. After 3 races, we will take a short break. There will be a temporary floating dock in position along the College of Marine

Science seawall. Water coolers for each team will be in place, and there will be coaching, snack, and substitution opportunities. Only one team (A and B divisions) will be allowed on the dock at a time. Please limit your time to 5 minutes (essentially a 30 minute break).

9. The final 3 races (assuming 6 teams participating) will commence following the break. Teams (A and B) will return to the USF docks, one team at a time. Remove rudders, drop mains, and lift boats onto the cradles. **VACATE THE DOCK AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** so that the next team can return.

10. Protest / breakdown forms will be provided on the regatta page.
