

COVID-19 Protocols for SRU Sailing

The C19 protocols reflect current regulations as established by the RIDOH and RI Executive Orders

Report Time is 10:00. First race will start at 10:30

When arriving you must park in the upper parking lot. Keep at least one parking place between the cars.

Please adhere to the guidelines below.

General Guidelines

- Nobody will be allowed on site who has been experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or been in contact with someone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms until they can show a negative C19 test result.
- All competitors must be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 upon arrival at Fort Adams. Screening will be conducted at the south entrance of Sail Newport's dry sail lot.
- All competitors and coaches must maintain 6 feet of social distancing while on site.
- Masks must be worn by everyone at all times on land, whether outside or indoors.
- All individuals (e.g., athletes, coaches, officials, athletic trainers, non-coaching personnel) must wear a face covering at all times while at the regatta venue and on the water, except while racing, eating or drinking.
- The bathrooms on the ground floor at 72 Fort Adams Drive are open.
- Competitors should follow signage and restrictions posted by Sail Newport and Fort Adams.

Regatta Guidelines

- Boats will be rigged in waves. Odd number boats will be rigged and launched first. Once all odd number boats have left the dock, competitors sailing even number boats may begin to rig.
 - Dollied boats may be rigged at any time
- Odd numbered boats will return to the dock first. Once all sailors have left the dock, even numbered boats can return to the dock.
 - Dollied boats may be derigged at any time
- Visiting teams are discouraged from bringing additional sailors outside those actively competing.
- There will be no competitors meeting. Protest hearings will need to be held remotely.
