2022 Green Wave Women's Team Race Additional Regatta Information

- Teams will meet at Community Sailing New Orleans to get their boats each morning
- Teams will be assigned a coach boat for the regatta. Alternates shall stay ashore. Only coaches may operate the coach boats. PFDs are required, and will be provided
- Restroom facilities are available at the Municipal Yacht Harbor, but it is advised that athletes come dressed in base layers at the beginning of the day.
- It is approximately a 15-20 minute sail from the dock to the racing area, and Race 1 will start on time
- Teams should plan to relocate their necessities to the Public Boat Launch (2-minute drive/10-minute walk)
- Bathroom breaks will be provided as needed between rounds
- At no time is anyone associated with the regatta allowed to enter the property of Southern Yacht Club unless with the express permission by the Tulane Coach.
- Umpires will not use flags, but will give verbal notification of either "green flag" or "red flag." In the case of a "red flag" the boat's sail number will also be hailed.
- We will try to have two umpires on each match.
- If an extended break is needed between rounds for the restroom, the break shall be for 30 minutes after the completion of the last race of the previous round.
- At the end of the day, teams shall put boats away with the direction of Tulane Sailing representatives.
- The ICSA rep will be the coach from the College of Charleston
