

GUIDANCE FOR REGATTA DAY OPERATION – 3/5-6/22

All events will follow Medical Guidance for ICSA Competition.

VISITING TEAM INFORMATION:

• **Masking will be optional in all indoor settings, except the following locations where masking will remain required:**

- Classrooms and Labs, Counseling and Health Services, public areas on first floor of library, Covid Testing Center, Athletic Training Room
- All shared transportation (shuttles; clubs, orgs and athletic travel)
- Large Events: masking required for vaccine exempt and those not current with booster.

• To the greatest extent practicable, all sailors and coaches will stay socially distant from visiting schools when on land.

• Sailors/teams will rotate boats.

SPECTATORS:

• Spectators and fans can come to the regatta and leave promptly after the regatta. Spectators may observe racing from the roof deck only. Access to a bathroom is available on the roof deck.

COMPETITOR'S MEETING NOTES

Channel/Current: Be aware of the shipping channel. Occasionally there is commercial traffic. It gets really deep in the middle and there is a lot of current: Low on Sat. 2:58 PM, Sunday 3:32 PM

Warnings: Do not sail far from the float toward the shore, there are big rocks there.

Courses and Course Area: See Techscore. We'll try to race as close and conveniently to the learning platform as possible, but realistically go where ever the best breeze is.

Lunch Break: There is no lunch break scheduled. But its early season; perhaps people will need to warm up so we'll play it by ear.

Parking: YOU CAN NOT PARK IN THE DRIVEWAY TO THE SAILING CENTER. [Parking](#) is available at the waterfront where ever you can find space, but keep the walking path and the beach clear. The spots along Bayside (Lot 13) are fair game. Otherwise you can park in the lot behind the mail room (Lot 11 & 12).

Sails, sail bags: You'll find sails on the rack in the boat storage area. Please tie the sail bags to the dock.

Water bottle filler: The water fountain/bottle filler is on the mid-level.

Rotations: Take off the VANG when you land on the dock to rotate. DO NOT STEP ON THE BOW OF THE SAILBOATS.

Rudders: Rudders are in the boats. Double check your universals. You will not get redress if you capsize and your rudder falls out of the boat. Please make sure it is tied in.

Gear storage: Please keep all gear in the boat storage area rather than the classroom. Everyone is of course welcome to use the classroom WITH A MASK ON and deck. Just keep those areas free of gear.

MNS: We share the waterfront with Marine and Natural Sciences, please be respectful of their gear in the water and on the dock.
