1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with host, Cal Poly, SLO.
- 1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements.
- 2.2. All sailors, coaches, and other personnel who will be at the venue must be able to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours or rapid test taken within 24 hours of the event before arrival.
- 2.3. This regatta will have both an open and women's fleet each consisting of 2 divisions. Schools may enter as many teams as desired. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. Teams shall confirm their participation online via the PCCSC scheduling sheet and with the host by February 21, 2022.

3. ENTRY FEES

- 3.1. Entry Fee is \$25 per boat and will be due by competitors meeting at 10:00 a.m. on March 5th. Entry fee includes dinner and breakfast for all team members Saturday night and Sunday morning.

4. BOATS & SAILS

Each team entered is responsible for providing PCCSC-legal sails and boats. A limited number of charters are available for \$100. Please request charters by February 28th.

6. COMPETITOR'S MEETING AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The competitors meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 5th on the first floor deck of Morro Bay Yacht Club. The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting.

7. RACING AREA/LAUNCHING

- 7.1. The regatta will be sailed out of the Morro Bay Yacht Club. The intended racing area will be the south basin of Morro Bay. Rotations will be held off the public dock. Racing location is weather and tide permitting.
- 7.2. Launching will occur in two places: Morro Bay launch ramp located on Embarcadero about 1 minute past MBYC, as well as at the MBYC crane. The launch ramp is recommended, the crane is time permitting.
- 8. COACHING**

All coaching should be done from the public dock. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee. Coaches are not allowed on the water.
- 9. SCORING**

Low point scoring system will be used in accordance with ICSA Procedural Rules.
- 10. SATURDAY DINNER**

Dinner will be held at MBYC on Saturday, March 5th immediately after racing. Please RSVP with a team headcount for dinner by Monday, February 28th. Seating will not be available inside the yacht club due to COVID-19. Please notify in advance of any allergies or diet restrictions.
- 11. SUNDAY BREAKFAST**

Pancake breakfast will be held at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday, March 6th. Coffee, tea, hot chocolate, fruit and pancakes will be provided. Please notify in advance of any allergies or diet restrictions.
- 12. HOUSING**

Please contact Corey Quillen if you are looking for housing. MBYC members and Cal Poly team members have generously offered to provide housing for sailors, however housing is limited.

Take a left on Embarcadero

- 14. PARKING AND BOAT STORAGE**

Parking is free everywhere surrounding yacht club but limited. There is a parking lot in front of a large tin shed, directly across from the yacht club, you may park in. Trailers can be parked in both the MBYC boat yard and launch areas overnight. Boats can be stored on MBYC dock on dollies overnight.
