PACIFIC COAST OPEN DINGHY CHAMPIONSHIP
Santa Barbara Yacht Club
April 9-10, 2022



RULES: This regatta shall be governed by rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the ICSA Procedural Rules, and the PCCSC Standing Rules.

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with the Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC).

HOST TEAM: UC Santa Barbara Sailing Team

FORMAT: The Pacific Coast Open Dinghy Championship will be a 2-division rotational event. One division will be on the water while one is on land.

ELIGIBILITY: All PCCSC Regular or Provisional Member Schools. A maximum of one (1) coed varsity team. As per the PCCSC Standing Rules, all competitors are required to wear their school pinnies. Sailors must meet all ICSA eligibility requirements and may be required to verify enrollment at the school they are representing.

ENTRY: Eligible teams must notify the host school and the Conference Commissioner by signing up on the PCCSC Live Schedule by Friday, March 25 at 11:59pm. The PCCSC Live Schedule is available at:

FEES: There is \$100 per team entry fee payable to 'PCCSC'.

BOATS/SAILS: Boats and sails are provided. Boats will be CFJ's.

QUALIFICATION: This event shall serve as the PCCSC Qualifier for the Open Fleet Race National Championship.

VENUE: The sailing venue will be announced at the Competitor Meeting. The location for boat storage for the weekend is at the UCSB docks.

DOCUMENTATION: Record of Participation (RP) forms must be completed online at ts.collegesailing.org by midnight on Sunday.

PROTESTS & APPEALS: In accordance with rule 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted. If the requirements are not met, the decisions of the protest committee may be appealed.

SAFETY: A U.S. Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type III, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.

HOUSING:

HOTELS: There are several hotels on Cabrillo Blvd. within walking distance of the regatta site. Early reservations are usually necessary. More affordable options are also available in Santa Barbara or Goleta within a 15 minute drive. SBYC recommends that hotel reservations be made as far in advance as possible. Visit:

PARKING: Parking at the venue is restricted to certain areas as dictated in 'Attachment P - Parking'. Trailers and boats may be left overnight in the harbor parking lot in designated areas if desired.

DIRECTIONS:

From LA: Take US 101 North to Santa Barbara

Exit Garden St, Turn Left

Turn Right onto Cabrillo Blvd

Turn Left onto Harbor Way

Bear Left immediately into public parking

Proceed along the harbor past 2 gates to the Launch Ramp

From SF: Take US 101 South to Santa Barbara

Exit Castillo St, turn Right, get in the center lane

Turn Right onto Cabrillo Blvd

Turn Left onto Harbor Way

Bear Left immediately into public parking

Proceed along the harbor past 2 gates to the Launch Ramp
