NOTICE OF RACE

HOST/SITE: USC/US Sailing Center – Long Beach, CA - www.uscsailing.org or www.usclub.org

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the ICSA Procedural Rules and the Racing Rules of Sailing, except as any of these are altered by this NOR, the Sailing Instructions (SI's), or the ICSA Procedural Rules.

BOATS/SALES: The regatta will be sailed in Club/Collegiate Flying Juniors. Each team must provide a PCCSC legal boat and sails. A limited number of boats can be chartered by emailing Mike Segerblom (mikesego@ussclub.org). Boats will be allocated by need and then order of request. Charter fee is \$100 per boat for 2 days. We encourage teams to charter to reduce trailer storage issues, space at the venue and ease of launching & travel. Teams should bring their own sails PCCSC legal Sails.

ENTRY FEE: \$50 per boat/team due by 10:00am on Saturday, March 19th. You are encouraged to pay in advance online for Entry Fees and Charters at:

TEAMS: All currently eligible ICSA sailors/PCCSC schools are encouraged to attend. This will be a two division event (A & B). All schools hoping to qualify for the PCCSC Dinghy PCCs must send at least one complete team (four eligible sailors).

FORMAT: We will determine if the Varsity and JV will sail together at the skippers meeting. If the fleet is split, one coed varsity boat and one all women's boat per school will be permitted to sail in the Varsity division. There is no limit on the number of JV teams per school. You will sail your own boat in all races. We will rotate divisions approximately every two races. The regatta is a two-day event with all races from both days being totaled for the team score in the regatta.

RACING AREA: We will likely sail either in the Alamitos Bay Turning Basin (rotating from the beach) or off the beach adjacent to one of the launch ramps (Granada or Claremont) on Ocean Blvd. In either case boats with launch, store and all morning and evening activities will be at the USSCLB.
