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#### 14 SAFETY

14.1 Competitors who require assistance from rescue boats should so signify by waving arms overhead. A competitor

who retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

- 14.2 Starts will not be delayed to accommodate capsized, swamped or just plain late boats. The RC shall be the sole evaluator of this situation.
- 14.3 All competitors shall wear drysuits with functional seals or a wetsuit which covers the full legs and torso. This rule <u>might</u> be temporarily rescinded by the PRO at times during the event.
- 14.4 Competitors shall keep the west roof area free for drone usage on both days. Film crews from the movie shall have exclusive use of this area. Flying a drone during the regatta is strictly forbidden this year as we will have very low flying helicopters, too.

Coaches shall be on dock, deck, or shoreline.
